Remit re Accommodation Supplement

- 1. Earlier this month the Council was asked to consider proposing a remit to Local Government New Zealand's (LGNZ) Annual General Meeting which will be held in Blenheim in July 2021.
- 2. Any remit requires the resolution of the proposing Council to be considered, along with support of at least five other councils. It must also be scrutinised by the President, Vice President and Chief Executive of LGNZ before being put forward to the AGM and this process is underway.
- 3. A proposed remit was drafted to meet the submission date to LGNZ of 14 May 2021. The intent of the remit is to prompt discussion between local and central government about the urgent need for review of the Accommodation Supplement system. The text of the remit and background is attached.
- 4. The support of the councils was sought and obtained, although like QLDC they have not have time to formally consider and adopt a stance on the remit prior to submission. However, like QLDC, political opinion has been canvassed by the respective Mayors/Chair. The supporting councils are Hamilton, Nelson and Porirua District Councils and Southland, Clutha and Central Otago District Councils.
- 5. This report seeks retrospective adoption by Council of the proposed remit. If adopted, Council will then advise LGNZ that the remit is fully adopted.

Timing of Delivery of Spatial Plan

6. The Spatial Plan was originally planned to go to Council on 30 June for adoption. Following the submissions and hearings process the report from the Hearings Panel Chair will not be available in time to meet this date. As a result the Spatial Plan will now be presented to Council at the next available meeting, which is 29 July.
