Purpose of the Report | Te Take mo te Puroko

Context | Horopaki

Local Government Chief Officers' Group meeting

- 1. The Local Government Chief Executives Group is a professional development network of Australian and New Zealand Local Government Chief Executives. This is the first in person meeting since pre-COVID. The meeting will take place in Cairns, Australia, 26-28 July 2023. The cost of the Chief Executive attending is estimated to be \$4,800 which includes event registration, travel, accommodation and per diem.
- 2. The Council's approval for the Chief Executive to attend is sought.

Event: 2023 Asia Pacific Cities Summit & Mayors' Forum

- 3. The Mayors' Forum is an opportunity for elected government leaders to come together and share their insights, discuss trends and issues facing their cities and develop solutions to promote growth and prosperity in cities. Participants will develop their own global network of influential peers and learn the latest trends and opportunities in city management.
- 4. It will be held in Brisbane, Australia, 11-13 October 2023. Topics covered in 2023 programme include:
 - a. Cites of Connection technology, data and the people
 - b. Cities of Sustainability adapting to growth, inclusivity and wellbeing
 - c. Cities of Legacy creating events for prosperity and longevity
- 5. It is proposed that the Mayor and Chief Executive both attend. Estimated costs including registration, accommodation and travel (all in accordance with the Sensitive Expenditure Policy) is approximately \$9,865. Approval for attendance at this Forum by the Mayor and the Chief Executive is sought.

Proposed Amendment to Wanaka-Upper Clutha Community Board Delegations and Terms of Reference

- 6. The Wānaka-Upper Clutha Community Board has worked on updating the Delegations and Terms of Reference since the 2022 election. The Board considered the updated Delegations and Terms of Reference at the Board meeting held on 16 February and recommended them to Council for approval.
- 7. The Wānaka-Upper Clutha Community Board propose a number of amendments to remove duplication or inconsistency with other documents, bylaws, legislation and Council resolutions. The amendments are also proposed to provide the Wānaka-Upper Clutha Community Board with greater visibility and input over matters which the members believe are important to retain local oversight. These have been initially considered by staff and responses provided based on requirements of relevant legislation, operational efficiency and maintaining a consistent level of service throughout the district.

Climate Reference Group Terms of Reference

- 8. Alongside the review of the Climate Reference Group membership, officers have reviewed and updated the Terms of Reference. The changes are to include a purpose that has been co-designed with the group, updates to ways of working to reflect developments since the group was established and inclusion of an honorarium payment to members.
- 9. The Terms of Reference also establishes that the Independent Chairperson will be appointed through a public, contestable process.



- 10. The Mayor has endorsed this recommendation.
- 11. Changes to the membership of the Climate Reference Group is dealt with separately in a public excluded section of this report as it contains personal information about the candidates.
