Plan Change 49: Earthworks

Queenstown Lakes District Council gives notice as of **24 September 2014**, that a Summary of Decisions Requested is available for inspection for the above plan change.

How do I make a further submission?

A further submission can only support or oppose matters raised in original submissions and must not raise new matters. You can only make a further submission if you represent a relevant aspect of the public interest (e.g. a community association or environmental organisation) or if you have an interest in the Plan Change that is greater than the general public (e.g. the Plan Change affects your property rights).

All further submissions must be received no later than **08 October 2014** and, within 5 working days of lodging it with Council you must serve a copy of it on the person(s) who made the original submission(s).

What happens next?

The Council will hold a public hearing to assess the plan change and all original and further submissions lodged to it, at which submitters may present their submissions. A decision will then be issued by the Council to withdraw, retain or modify the Plan Change. Any submitter/ further submitter not satisfied with the decision may appeal that decision to the Environment Court.
