- [1] On 21 March 2019 the court issued a Minute in relation to Stage 2 of the proposed Queenstown Lakes District Plan and gave general directions and waivers ahead of the appeal period ending (next week).
- [2] It has now come to the court's attention that there is some confusion with one of the directions, specifically (2)(d) which confirmed section 274 notices must be served within 20 working days after the period for lodging a notice of appeal ends. The requirement for s 274 parties to serve their notice within 15 working days after the period for lodging a notice of appeal ends is <u>waived</u>.
- [3] The direction should have stated:

section 274 notices must be <u>lodged and</u> served within 20 working days after the period for lodging a notice of appeal ends. The requirement for s 274 parties to <u>lodge and</u> serve their notice within 15 working days after the period for lodging a notice of appeal ends is <u>waived</u>.

[4] For the avoidance of doubt, the period for filing s274 notices ends on **Wednesday 5 June 2019**.
