
ATTACHMENT A - Location and Licence Area

ATTACHMENT B – Trailer and Potential Design






ATTACHMENT D – Resource Consent Plans

D1 - Map of Jet Ski Tour Routes

Route A is the main anticipated route (approx. 90 minutes) departing from Lakeland Wanaka's beachfront license/jetties. The tour will proceed through Roys Bay to Ruby Island in a 'follow the leader' type group, to get passengers comfortable operating their jet skis and pass through the normally busier part of the Lake in a tighter group. From here passengers will be given a little more freedom following the general direction of the guide but given more space due to the decrease in other Lake traffic. The tour will proceed into Glendhu Bay for a viewpoint of Mount Aspiring, and towards Mou Tapu Island. Passengers will be given the opportunity to swim off their jet ski beside Mou Tapu Island before returning towards Roy's Bay following the guides direction before the tour forms the 'follow the leader' group again to get back through Roy's Bay to the beachfront.



Route B will be offered as an on-enquiry basis for longer tours (3-4 hours). Departing from Lakeland Wanaka's beachfront license/jetties the tour will proceed through Roys Bay to Ruby Island in a 'follow the leader' type group, to get passengers comfortable operating their jet skis and pass through the normally busier part of the Lake in a tighter group. From here passengers will be given a little more freedom following the general direction of the guide but given more space due to the decrease in other Lake traffic. The tour will proceed towards Mou Tapu Island then to Mou Waho Island where the jet skis will be beached, and passengers will be guided on a walk to the top of the island. The jet ski tour will return back towards Roy's Bay in the same fashion as it left before forming the 'follow the leader' group again to get back through Roy's Bay to the beachfront.



Route C

Route options C and D are alternative options that may be run on market demand. These trips will mainly be run when weather renders Routes A and B too difficult or unsafe due to wind and wave action.





MAP OF LAKE CRUISE TOUR ROUTES (POWERED VESSEL)


Route A
