

# Civil Defence – Advice for campers

New Zealand is in **ALERT LEVEL 4** as the country unites to tackle the spread of Covid-19. Emergency rules apply – your adherence to these rules is required.

You are required to restrict your movements and you must stay in one place for at least the next four weeks.

### Key guidance

- > Campers must find an appropriate location, and remain there for the **full duration of the lock down period**. Campers should not expect to travel during this period.
- > QLDC will not be enforcing its normal two-day maximum stay for campers, to enable you to stay in a single location throughout this period.
- > All existing responsible camping boundaries and zones will be enforced.
- > Camping is not permitted at the Luggate Red Bridge or Albert Town sites.

### Where you can camp

Campgrounds and Hotels/Motels are considered essential services, so are allowed (and encouraged) to stay open during alert Level 4.

Campers are asked to move to one of these sites immediately. High hygiene protocols will be in place and services will be available.

If you choose not to stay in a commercial campsite you **must have a dedicated bathroom and shower onboard (and the ability to hold all waste for the duration) and use the dump station at that campground.**

**You must stay in one location for the duration of the lockdown. If your vehicle cannot do this safely you must go to one of the listed campgrounds immediately.**

## Does the 4 week lockdown mean we have to self-isolate for 4 weeks?

Yes. Please find an appropriate location and remain where you are for the next four weeks, or until the government lowers the alert level, with the exception of an individual sourcing essential supplies.

## Are we allowed to travel around at all or stay in one place the whole time?

Everyone is required severely restrict their movements. Please find an appropriate location and remain where you are for the next four weeks, or until the government lowers the alert level.

## Will all public facilities be closed for use? Toilets, laundromats, etc

Laundromats will be closed. Limited public toilets will remain open for those who are not self-isolating. However if you are not staying in a commercial camp site, you are expected to have a toilet and shower on board.

## Will gas canister replacements be available and where from?

Yes. You will be able to get canister replacements at fuel stations, which will remain open during the lock down period.
