

ROBINS ROAD WASTEWATER UPGRADES

Queenstown

Work to upgrade wastewater infrastructure on Robins Road in Queenstown begins in **early January 2026**, which will include a new pipeline running along Robins Road from the Horne Creek bridge to connect with an existing pipeline under Queenstown Recreation Ground.

By upgrading this infrastructure we can provide enough capacity for future housing in the area, and reduce the risk of severe weather leading to wastewater overflows that affect private properties or enter Horne Creek and Lake Whakatipu.

Work to install a new watermain in the area will start ahead of wastewater upgrades and begin on **Monday 10 November 2025**. This part of the project will only require the temporary closure of a section of footpath on the east side of Robins Road.
