Queenstown Bike Festival

To ensure the safety of all Lake users, public notice is hereby given that pursuant to the Queenstown Lakes District Navigation Safety Bylaw 2018, bylaw clause 31 has been invoked to temporarily authorise a reserved area for a special event. The 2024 Queenstown Bike Festival lake jump and floating log ride will be held in Queenstown Bay on 19 January 2024

This reserved area be in place on **Friday 19 January 2024** and applies to both private and commercial users.

Queenstown Bay, Queenstown

Exemption: **Temporary Reserved Area**

Date: 19 January 2024

Time: 2.00pm to 9.00pm

Location: Jetty 5 (Steamer Wharf) from opposite the Earnslaw ticket office to O'Regans Wharf and both sides of Jetty 122 (from opposite Lake Street to the Steamer Wharf) extending 50 metres out from the jetty structure.

From 2.00pm on 19 January 2024, in the interests of public safety, the reserved area will be in force. No unauthorised vessels are to enter the reserved area until the all clear is given by event officials.

All vessels are reminded that, while on the water, they must comply at all times with the Maritime Transport Act 1994 and the QLDC Navigation Safety Bylaw 2018.
