# Further Submission in support of, or in opposition to, a submission on a notified plan change

To: Queenstown Lakes District Council ("Council")

Name of Further Submitter: Malaghans Investments Limited ("Submitter")

#### **Further Submission:**

1. The submitter makes this further submission in support of and in opposition to specified submissions on Stage 3b of the Proposed Queenstown Lakes District Plan ("PDP").

#### Interest greater than the general public has:

- 2. The Submitter has interests in the subject matter greater than the interest that the general public has, including because the Submitter:
  - (a) owns property located in Skippers and is directly affected by any changes in zoning in this locale; and
  - (b) made a submission (#31022) on Stage 3b of the Proposed Queenstown Lakes District Plan ("PDP") seeking the identification of a Rural Visitor Zone in Skippers, the outcome of which could be impacted by the consideration of the other submissions.

# Scope of Further Submission:

- 3. This further submission is on the submissions of:
  - (a) Mr Ben Hohneck (submission #31012); and
  - (b) Mr Brett Mills (submission #31015).
- 4. The particular parts of the submissions **supported** are:
  - (a) The identification and appropriateness of providing for a Rural Visitor Zone at Skippers.
- 5. The particular parts of the submissions **opposed** are:
  - (a) The specific location and limited extent of the Rural Visitor Zone at Skippers and, in particular, if the Rural Visitor Zone rezoning sought in submissions #31012 and #31015 were to be adopted in exclusion of the Rural Visitor Zone rezoning sought in #31022.

- 6. The reasons are as follows:
  - (a) The Submitter made a submission (#31022) that broadly sought similar relief, albeit over different properties in Skippers.
  - (b) It is appropriate for the reasons given in submission #31022, for that relief to be granted.
  - (c) The Submitter does not oppose, in principle, the additional rezoning sought in submissions #31012 and #31015.
  - (d) Given that three owners of large landholdings have all independently sought a Rural Visitor Zone it this locale, the specific location and limited extent of the Zone as shown in submissions #31012 and #31015 should be revisited with the intent of providing for an integrated and coherent Rural Visitor Zone (including the land subject to submission #31022) within this locale in Skippers Canyon.
  - (e) The Submitter will engage with Mr Hohneck and Mr Mills in regard to potentially presenting a joint case at the hearing.

## Relief sought:

7. The Submitter seeks that submissions #31012 and #31015 be **allowed** subject to the necessary amendments to give effect to the relief as sought, in particular, that the relief sought in submission #31022 is not compromised or otherwise undermined.

#### Wish to be heard and potential for a joint case:

- 8. The Submitter wishes to be heard in support of its further submission.
- 9. If others make similar submissions, the Submitter will consider presenting a joint case at any hearing. As identified above, this could include Mr Hohneck and Mr Mills.
