

Queenstown Airport – Future Management, Operation and Development

Adopted – Council 31 October 1997

Council rescinds its previous decisions dated 23 May 1995 and 26 September 1995.

The Council adopts the following policies for the future management, operation and development of Queenstown Airport:

- The Board of the Queenstown Airport Corporation shall adopt, promote and implement the concept of being a “good neighbour”.
- The Queenstown Airport Corporation will set up a Noise Abatement committee under the terms of NZS 6805.
- The Council in its role as shareholder will appoint directors to the Board of the Queenstown Airport Corporation who, unless exceptional circumstances exist, will not be members of the Council.
- The Council supports the Board of Queenstown Airport Corporation in their funding of developments by whatever means are agreed appropriate between the Queenstown Airport Corporation directors and the Queenstown-Lakes District Council as community representatives, from time to time.
- Notwithstanding the acceptance of the concept of being a good neighbour, the Council recognises and accepts that the Queenstown Airport will remain at Frankton and the Council expects the Queenstown Airport Corporation to establish, maintain and operate an airport on behalf of the community within the area of the Council that is consistent with the growth of the district, the dependence of the district on tourism, the expectations of the community at large.
- To provide for appropriate growth and demand for air services at Queenstown Airport over at least the next 10-15 years.

To support and provide for the extension to the eastern end of the main runway, and the development of a taxiway parallel to the main runway.
