Queenstown Lakes District Council gives public notice as of 23 December 2009 that it has prepared Plan Change 40 to District Plan. The Plan Change will be publically notified again on 13 January 2010.

The purpose of Plan Change 40 is as follows:

To realign the boundaries between the Low Density Zone and Open Space Zone within the District Plan to bring the zone boundaries into line with the Outline Development Master Plan consented for the Peninsula Bay development. This change is intended to give effect to the intent of the original Variation to the District Plan for Peninsula Bay.

What happens next?

Following the notification of decisions sought on submissions, persons may <u>only</u> make a further submission if they represent a relevant aspect of the public interest or if they have an interest in the Plan Change that is greater than the public generally.

The council will appoint a hearing committee to assess the plan change and the submissions lodged to it, including further submissions. The committee will hold a public hearing to enable submitters to present their submissions.

Following deliberation, a decision will be issued by the council to withdraw, retain or modify the plan change accordingly. Any person who was a submitter, or lodged a further submission, and who is not satisfied with the decision reached, can appeal that decision to the Environment Court.
