CONTEXT | HOROPAKI

Ballantyne Road

1. Attached are updates on Ballantyne Road resealing from the QLDC Project Management Office, being a project tracker (Attachment A) and timeline slide (Attachment B). It is noted that construction is programmed to start in spring 2020.

Covid-19 Emergency Response

- 2. In mid-March the Council, in response to COVID -19, activated the emergency operations centre and the Wānaka incident control centre. The key priority since that time has been to ensure the basic needs of our community can be met including food, accommodation and health and wellbeing support.
- 3. Since 24 March, an online QLDC welfare registration form has received more than 10,000 requests for assistance including accommodation, essential shopping, clothing, bedding, heating, job hunting and support services. Note that this number includes duplicate requests for assistance.

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- 4. Around 4,100 of these requests are from people on employment or short stay visitor visas.
- 5. Wānaka-based social service agencies have been heavily involved in the QLDC welfare response and delivery. This focus will continue as social service agencies support the recovery planning and move into delivery of recovery initiatives to the Upper Clutha and wider Queenstown Lakes communities.

Minor Improvement Projects

6. Board members have been asked to provide feedback to Property and Infrastructure staff on the list of Wānaka based minor improvement projects for the 2020/21 programme. This feedback will determine the priority of projects. Once the priority has been established, the Board will receive regular updates on delivery progress and spend vs budget. For this reason, a list of projects has not been appended to this month's report, although it will be the intention going forward.

NZTA Stakeholder Tour

 Prior to the Lockdown, I attended a presentation in Queenstown facilitated by Jim Harland (Director of Regional Relationships, NZTA) and Nicole Rosie (NZTA CE) where the proposed \$90M infrastructure spend was outlined. It was useful to see how the funding would be apportioned throughout the district, in particular, projects in the Upper Clutha.

Wānaka A&P Show

- 8. Board members, Wānaka Ward Councillors and staff from across the organisation spent two very enjoyable days staffing the QLDC display at the annual Wānaka A&P Show. The Council has done this for several years now and it's a great opportunity to communicate directly with both residents and visitors.
- 9. In 2020, key issues focused on were the 2020-2021 Annual Plan, the Climate Action Plan and Civil Defence Preparedness. There were also displays, information and advice from Wastebusters, Department of Conservation, and Dr Compost, and the popular book sale from our libraries.

Eely Point Ramp and Jetty Replacement

10. The Eely Point Ramp and Jetty replacement was included as part of the Wānaka Lakefront Development Plan Crown Infrastructure Partner shovel-ready project that was recently submitted to central government. At the time of writing, advice has not been received on whether any of the projects submitted by QLDC has been successful in securing central government funding.

Liaison positions, community associations, and Council meeting updates

11. Members are invited to report on the Board-related activities they have been involved in since the previous meeting, and Councillors are asked to comment on any matters of interest from recent Council meetings.
