









RECREATION GROUND PUMP STATION AND WASTEWATER MAIN UPGRADE

Work is underway to construct a new Wastewater Pump Station at the Tāhuna Queenstown Recreation Ground and upgrade the rising main (wastewater pipeline) through the town centre. The project is expected to take until the end of February 2021 to complete and is a key part of Council's plan to accommodate growth and provide more resilience across the district's wastewater network.



There is likely to be a number of temporary road closures, detours and temporary loss of on-street carparking while work is underway. We'll work hard to minimise disruption as much as possible and keep affected residents updated as the project progresses.

-  **STAGE 1** – Construction of a new wastewater pump station. March 2020-February 2021.
-  **STAGE 2** – Construction of a wastewater pipeline. August-October 2020.
-  **STAGE 3** – Construction of a wastewater pipeline and connection to main sewer line. May-October 2020.
