Context | Horopaki

1. The Procurement Team has been developing a forward-facing Annual Procurement Plan (refer to Attachment A) to provide potential suppliers with information regarding upcoming procurements, thereby allowing them a view on the upcoming pipelines of work.
2. The base of this plan was the Long Term Plan, supplemented with OPEX procurements and FY25/26 timeframes requested from Directorates. The initial plan shows only financial year quarters, however future plans are intended to show:
 - Timeframes by month;
 - Whether the process will be ring-fenced to supplier panels or run as an open-market procurement; and
 - Additional procurements based on category analysis (e.g., consolidation of similar procurements currently <\$10k individually).
3. This plan will be made available on the Queenstown Lakes District Council’s (QLDC) website and along with the existing reporting on contracts awarded through Government Electronic Tenders Service (GETS), will provide a snapshot of planned procurements and contracts awarded for each financial year.
4. Information gathering for FY26/27 has begun with the intent that the FY26/27 Plan will be made available via the QLDC website by 1 July 2026.
