HEARING STREAM 06 – RESIDENTIAL

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MAY IT PLEASE THE PANEL:

- The Queenstown Lakes District Council (Council) filed a Memorandum of Counsel on 7 October 2016 (this morning) informing the Hearing Panel (Panel) that the Council intends to serve notice on those submitters whose points have been transferred from the Subdivision hearing stream (04) to the Residential hearing stream (06).
- The transferred provisions listed in this morning's memorandum are notified Rules 27.5.1 (redraft 27.6.1), 27.5.1.2 (redraft 27.7.12.2) and 27.5.2 (redraft 27.7.13). The Panel has helpfully issued a Minute with directions today.
- 3. Counsel has subsequently recognised that Ms Amanda Leith has also addressed notified Rule 27.5.3 (redraft 27.7.14) in her evidence summary for the Low Density Residential chapter. Similar to redraft Rule 27.7.13, redraft Rule 27.7.14 is also an exception to the specified minimum lot areas in redraft 27.6.1 for the Low Density Residential Area, and in the Council's view should also be considered as part of this Residential hearing stream 06.
- 4. The Council has also identified that some submitters were missing from the list in the Schedule of this morning's memorandum. A full list of the relevant submitters (whether addressed in the Subdivision s42A or not) is attached in Schedule 1, with the additions shown in red font. As per the memorandum filed this morning, those submitters in italics did not receive notice of the Residential hearing stream.
- **5.** Council seeks the following additional directions from the Panel:
 - **5.1** that it serve this memorandum, on all submitters listed in Schedule 1; and
 - **5.2** directions consistent with the Panel's Minute/directions issued today, in relation to notified Rule 27.5.3 (redraft 27.7.14).

6. Counsel apologises for any inconvenience caused, and is able to address the Panel on this matter on Monday at the hearing, if necessary.
