

## Examples of how trail crossings can be managed – April 2026

The table below shows successful examples of how trail crossings are managed in the Ben Lomond Reserve in Queenstown. These represent examples, not the specific signage or infrastructure that would be used to manage trail crossings in the Mount Iron Reserve. How each trail crossing operates would be determined through the detailed design stage of any trail development.
