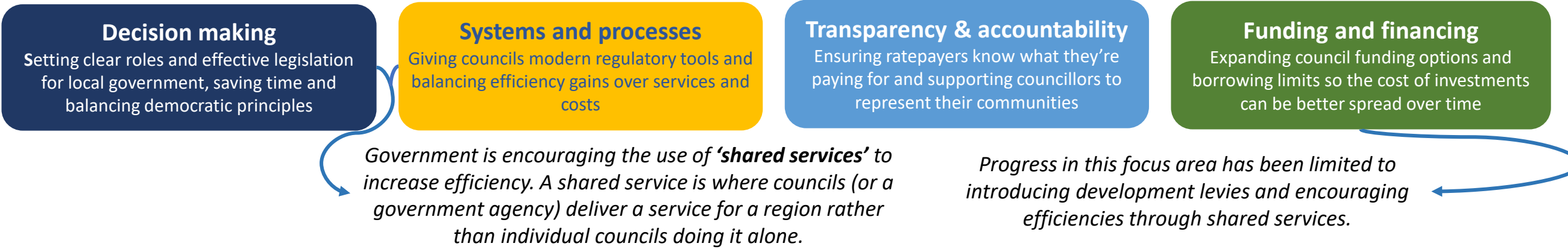


Parliament’s local government reform programme aims to reduce the rates burden by getting councils ‘back to the basics’ and improve efficiency and accountability. The programme has **four areas of focus** and overlaps with Local Water Done Well, Going for Housing Growth and Regional Deals. The programme is ongoing with recent announcements including rate capping, reorganisation of Council’s roles and ministerial portfolios. This A3 summarises the major reforms and their progress.
