About us

Guru Nanak Darbar Queenstown is a Sikh community organisation that has been active in the Queenstown Lakes region since 2020 and was formally registered as a charitable trust in 2026. The trust is responsible for conducting Sikh religious rituals, spiritual services, and community support activities. Guru Nanak Darbar Queenstown is supported nationally by the Supreme Sikh Society of Aotearoa New Zealand, which acts as an umbrella organisation for Sikh community groups across the country.

Our Queenstown Lakes community

We currently operate a temporary Gurdwara Sahib (temple) located at Hanley's Farm in Queenstown.

Sri Guru Granth Sahib Ji Parkash (ceremony) is respectfully conducted at this facility, and regular prayers and religious observances are also conducted.

Our community includes between 600 and 700 people living across Queenstown, Wānaka and surrounding areas, including Cromwell.

Our events and activities

Guru Nanak Darbar Queenstown:

- » Conducts Sikh religious services and ceremonies.
- » Organises and celebrates Sikh festivals across different parts of Queenstown.
- » Provides spiritual and general support to Sikh families and newcomers.
- » Promotes Seva (selfless service) and Langar (community meals).
- » Teaches Punjabi language classes for children at the facility.
- » Collaborates with Gurdwara and Sikh organisations across New Zealand and internationally.
- » Welcome people of all backgrounds to learn about Sikhism and participate in community events.
