# **Commissioner Biographies**



## Jan Caunter (Papamoa)

Chair

Jan has been a hearing commissioner on 25 hearings for QLDC. She is a well-known and respected hearing commissioner for the Council. Jan has extensive experience in resource management and law nationwide. Prior to creating her own business Jan Caunter Ltd, her previous position was that of Environmental Counsel for Gallaway Cook Allan in Wanaka. Jan is a hearing commissioner for a number of Councils around NZ. In her role as a commissioner, she has sat alone or on panels of 2-4 commissioners. She has also been appointed by Environment Court Judge Newhook to sit on 3 Covid-19 Fast Track consenting panels, one of which was for Silverlight Studios in Wanaka.
