MEMORANDUM GRANTING LEAVE FOR COUNCIL TO FILE SUPPLEMENTARY EVIDENCE

- On 15 June 2016 the Hearing Panel received an request from the Council to file supplementary evidence in respect of a single submission which had not been addressed on the evidence or s.42A report circulated on 2 June last. The Memorandum filed confirms that the submitter, Mr Schmidt, was notified of the hearing on 13 June 2016, and suggested that Mr Schmidt be granted an extension to the time required to file any evidence to 24 June 2016.
- 2. This is a reasonable request. If this submission was not dealt with in the hearings commencing on 27 June next, the Hearing Panel would need to reconvene at a later time to hear this submission. Mr Schmidt has been provided with 10 working days notice of the hearing. However, Mr Schmidt is entitled to consider the supplementary evidence prior to deciding whether he wishes to appear and present any evidence at the hearing. On the ordinary processs being followed, the time has passed for him to request time to be heard.
- 3. On the basis of the above:
 - a) The request by Council to file supplementary evidence is granted;
 - b) Mr Schmidt is to be given until 12 noon on Monday 20 June 2016 to advise whether he wishes to be heard:
 - c) If Mr Schmidt does wish to be heard and is required to provide evidence in advance, that can be filed by 12 noon on Friday 24 2016.
