Plan Change 13: Kirimoko Block Plan Change

The purpose of this plan change is:

To provide for some of the predicted future residential growth of Wanaka by changing the zoning of that land known as the Kirimoko block, to enable residential development and the future development of the Catholic School, while retaining the amenity values of the site and the surrounding landscape.

Any person may make a submission to the proposed Plan Changes. Submission forms are available from the above locations. The closing date for submissions is **8 May 2007**. Submissions must be in writing and should be sent to:

Once submissions have closed, a summary of the decisions requested will be prepared. This will be publicly notified and any person may lodge a further submission in support or opposition to any original submission.

The Council will appoint a Hearing Committee to assess the plan change and the submissions lodged to it, including further submissions. A public hearing will be held to enable submitters to present their submissions.

Following deliberation, a decision will be issued by the Council to either withdraw, retain or modify the plan change. Any person who was a submitter, or lodged a further submission, and who is not satisfied with the decision reached, may appeal that decision to the Environment Court.
