INTRODUCTION

1. This memorandum of counsel is filed on behalf of the Queenstown Lakes District

Council (Council) in relation to the hearing on the Gertrude's Saddlery Limited

(GSL) and Larchmont Developments Limited (Larchmont) submissions on

Stage 1 of the Queenstown Lakes Proposed District Plan (PDP).

2. The purpose of this memorandum is for the Council to seek leave for one of its

experts, Mr Richard Bond, to not attend the council hearing scheduled for 1 -

3 February 2023.

3. Mr Bond has provided a short statement of geotechnical and natural hazard

evidence. He concludes that the qualitative level of risk posed to the submission

site is low, and the rezoning is not opposed from his perspective.

4. No contradictory evidence has been filed and geotechnical / natural hazards are

not considered to be an issue. If, after reading Mr Bond's evidence, the Panel

has no questions of Mr Bond, the Council respectfully seeks that Mr Bond be

excused from appearing at the council hearing.

5. This approach would contribute to an efficient hearing process and would also

minimise cost to the Council, as Mr Bond could avoid flying to Queenstown for

the hearing.
