## Rabbit control operation planned for Mount Iron Reserve, Wānaka

Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC) has employed the services of a professional contractor to carry out rabbit control in Mount Iron Reserve, Wānaka. This will take place in the southern area of the Mount Iron Reserve parallel to Wānaka-Luggate State Highway 84.

This control will be carried out from 8.00pm on Sunday 22 March for an estimated three-four hours, weather dependent. This work will be ongoing as required on Sunday evenings.

Experienced professional contractors will carry out the night shooting operation within a cordoned off area.

- Please respect the cordon and DO NOT ENTER when signage and cordon are present.
- Public walking tracks will be closed. If members of the public are asked to leave the area for their safety, please do so.
- Police have been notified of this rabbit control operation.
- Please be aware that noise from firearms, which are suppressed, may be heard outside of the operational area.
