## MINUTE IN REPLY TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UPPER CLUTHA ENVIRONMENTAL SOCIETY (INC) DATED 2 JULY 2016

- In response to the Hearing Panel's Memorandum on 1 July 2016 requesting the Council undertake a planning study of the Wakatipu Basin, Mr Haworth has filed a Memorandum on behalf of the Upper Clutha Environmental Society (Inc). Among other things, this Memorandum seeks that a similar study be undertaken in the Upper Clutha basin.
- 2. First, I remind Mr Haworth of the following statement in the Panel's Procedure Minute dated 25 January 2016 at page 3:

Once the hearings for a topic is completed, the Panel will not accept additional material on that topic, other than in exceptional circumstances which will require approval of the Panel Chair.

- I am not aware of any exceptional circumstances that would justify receipt of additional material in respect of Hearing Stream 2 at this late stage, and Mr Haworth does not suggest any in his Memorandum.
- 4. Second, the Panel's Memorandum of 1 July 2016 was a request to the Council that it undertake a study. If any other person wishes to make a request of the Council in similar vein, they should direct that request to the Council rather than the Hearing Panel.
- 5. Mr Haworth's Memorandum will not be considered by the Hearing Panel.
