Notice of intent to review the Ben Lomond and Queenstown Hill Reserve Management Plan 2005

PURSUANT TO SECTION 41 (5) OF THE RESERVES ACT 1977, Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC) hereby gives public notice of its intention to review the Ben Lomond and Queenstown Hill Reserve Management Plan 2005. The Reserve Management Plan directs management and development of Ben Lomond Reserve and Queenstown Hill, and the level of use and infrastructure. This includes the mountain biking and walking trails, recreation opportunities, commercial operators, landscape and biodiversity values, wilding removal and revegetation, as well as fire prevention.

During this notice phase, you are invited to provide informal feedback for the review of the Reserve Management Plan. Suggestions will inform a revised draft Reserve Management Plan that will be publicly notified inviting submissions, which will then be heard at a public hearing.
