All keys lost/not returned will be charged to the user at a rate of \$500.00 per key.

The above name/business when accessing an Open Space area or Council asset with the authorized Council Key must ensure that all vehicles accessing tracks, trails and green spaces are to have a current NZ or approved foreign driver's license. Hazards lights or amber flashing beacon is to be turned on before entering the area and remain active until the vehicle leaves the area.

Marker cones or signs are to be installed at all entry/exit point where possible. The vehicle speed is not to exceed 5k.p.h or a lesser speed as required by either track conditions or pedestrian numbers and behaviour.

Vehicles are not to have any materials or objects protruding from the footprint of the vehicle.

Allow 1.5 meter clearance when passing a pedestrian if possible, or slow to a speed that allows you to pass pedestrians or cyclists safely. If the pedestrian or cyclist has not acknowledged the vehicles presence please tap the horn to alert from a safe distance, do not use the horn in a way that will frighten anything.

Areas of ecological significance are to be avoided. Repairs are to be undertaken to any damage to the surface or turf caused by the vehicle use.
