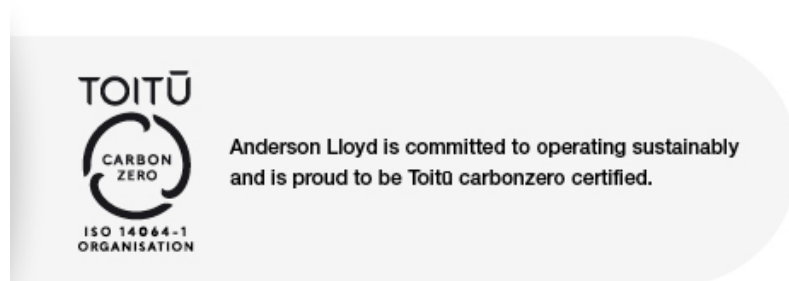
The memoranda are essentially duplicates, but filed on behalf of two separate submitters we represent.
