- **Day session:** 8.00am - 3.30pm
Prices start at \$38 for both Juniors and Seniors
- **Late session:** 3.30pm - 5.30pm, \$10 extra per child
- **Drop offs:** Doors open at 8.00am but no later than 9.30am please as it is very disruptive. Late fees will be charged if you pick your child up after 3.30pm and additional costs if after 5.30pm.

OTHER INFORMATION

All children MUST bring water bottles and warm clothes

- Sessions are based at Queenstown Events Centre or Queenstown Memorial Centre.
- The staff-child ratio will be no less than 1:10 and 1:8 on away days.
- Packed lunches are recommended. However, \$5 lunch combos, \$2.50 pizzas, \$2 noodle cups and \$2 ice blocks are available. Please place your order in the morning with the supervisors.
- Please bring a warm jacket, hat and good shoes, plus sun hats on hot days.

- Please do not bring valuables to the Holiday Programme including new toys, iPods, PSPs, jewellery or money.
