# Plan Change 33 – Non-Residential Activities within the Residential, Rural Living and Township Zones

As of 2 April 2008, Council has prepared the above Plan Change to the Partially Operative District Plan.

## **Purpose of the Plan Change**

To close a loophole that currently exists within the Residential, Rural Living and Township Zones that allows inappropriate activities such as panel beating, spray painting and fibre glassing as a permitted activity. The closing of this loophole will assist in ensuring the amenity values anticipated within the District's residential areas are maintained.

# What happens next?

Following the receipt of public submissions, a summary of the submissions lodged will be prepared. This will be publicly notified and any person may lodge a further submission in support or opposition to any original submission.

The council will appoint a hearing committee to assess the plan change and the submissions lodged to it, including further submissions. The committee will hold a public hearing to enable submitters to present their submissions.

Following deliberation, a decision will be issued by the council to withdraw, retain or modify the plan change accordingly. Any person who was a submitter, or lodged a further submission, and who is not satisfied with the decision reached, can appeal that decision to the Environment Court.
