## **REQUEST FOR OFFICIAL INFORMATION – RELEASE OF INFORMATION**

We refer to your official information request dated 6 December 2021. You requested the following information from the Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC):

• A copy of the Council's risk assessment for the Arrowtown Pool in making the decision to mandate proof of vaccination

## **QLDC** response

The QLDC Executive Leadership Team (ELT) made the decision on whether to require facilities to be accessible only by vaccinated people at an ELT meeting on  $1^{ST}$  December 2021.

The QLDC Human Resources Manager, Chris Shield, prepared a memo to the ELT to assist in the decision-making process. We have attached a copy of this briefing memo in the below link:

The ELT made the assessment to require facilities to be accessible only by vaccinated people verbally in the meeting on 1<sup>ST</sup> December 2021.
