#### MAY IT PLEASE THE PANEL

- This memorandum is filed on behalf of Queenstown Lakes District Council (Council) regarding the order of Council witnesses to appear at the hearing, beginning on Monday, 24 July 2017. The intention of filing this in advance of Monday, is to assist the Panel and submitters as to when it is likely that evidence on a particular rezoning will be presented.
- After opening with legal submissions, the Council will present 'strategic and dwelling capacity evidence' first, including economic experts. This will be followed by Ulrich Glasner (infrastructure) and Charlie Watts (Geotechnical) who will present evidence on all relevant submissions. Then, generally, the Council will move through each s42A 'Group', calling the Council's landscape and transport evidence (and for Group 2, ecology and Group 1D noise), alongside the relevant planner.
- 3. This means that for each 'Group' of submissions (ie. Group 1A, 1B etc) the Council's landscape and transport experts (and ecology for Group 2 and Group 1D noise) will attend, present to the Panel and be available for questions alongside the planner, allowing the Panel to generally deal with each submission and each relevant reporting planner and expert at the same time.
- In order to accommodate this way of giving evidence, the Council respectfully requests that the hearing room be set up with all of the relevant witnesses for each Group at the table before the Panel. The Panel can then work through the submissions in the order they appear in the relevant section 42A report. The planner, followed by any expert witnesses who have included a paragraph in their summary of evidence on that particular submission (or group of submission), will be read out. Once all witnesses have read out their summary statements on that submission (if applicable), then the Panel will ask its questions of the expert witnesses and relevant planner. For clarity, the proposed schedule, although of course subject to change depending on how long it takes to work through each 'Group', is set out in **Appendix 1**.
- 5. In addition, there are some submission points addressed in both Groups 1A and 1B, that relate to the same or similar areas of land. This approach was (generally) taken as Ms Ruth Evans was considering rezoning requests to a business zone, whereas Ms Kimberley Banks was considering requests to a

residential zone. To accommodate this request Ms Evans and Ms Banks will appear at the hearing together along with the relevant expert witnesses to provide summary statements and answer the Panel's questions on those particular submissions. The relevant submissions are set out in **Appendix 2**.

**6.** Counsel has asked its witnesses to prepare its summaries of evidence in this way.
