FY26 SNAPSHOT

- Celebrated Queenstown Airport's 90th anniversary
- Named NZ Airports Large Airport of the Year
- Revenue of \$87.1 million
- Underlying profit* after tax of \$34.0 million
- Reported profit after tax of \$9.1 million
- Total annual dividend to shareholders of \$20.4 million
- QLDC share equates to \$470 per ratepayer
- Approved \$65 million programme of airfield improvements
- Community sentiment score 77% (up from 69%)
- Customer experience score 4.32 (up from 4.25)

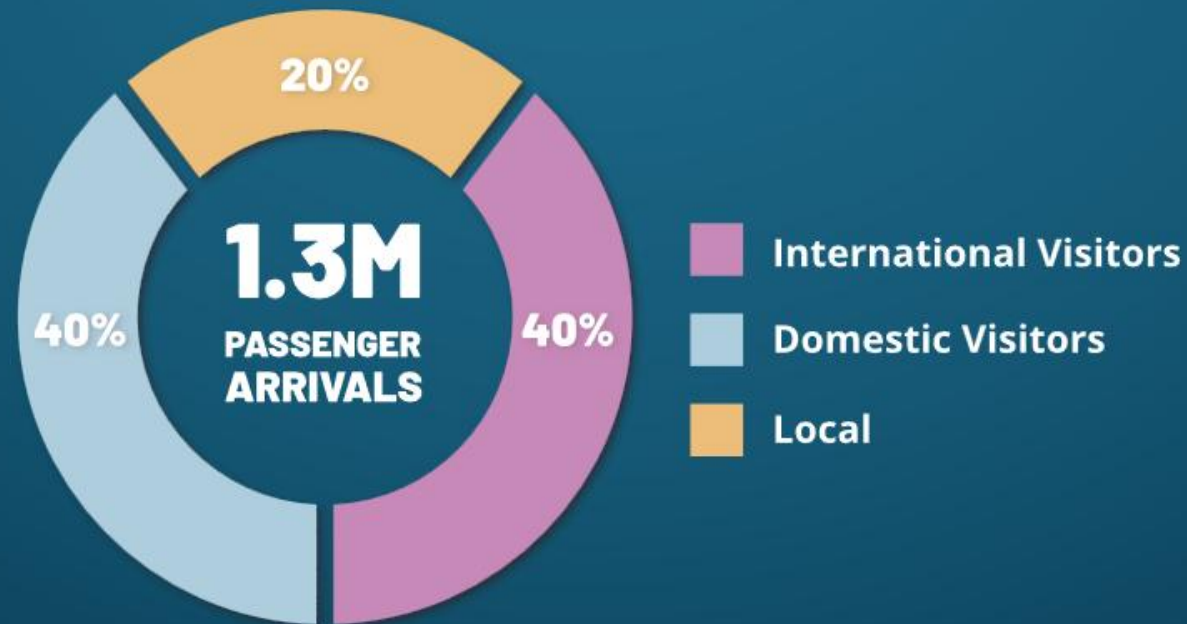

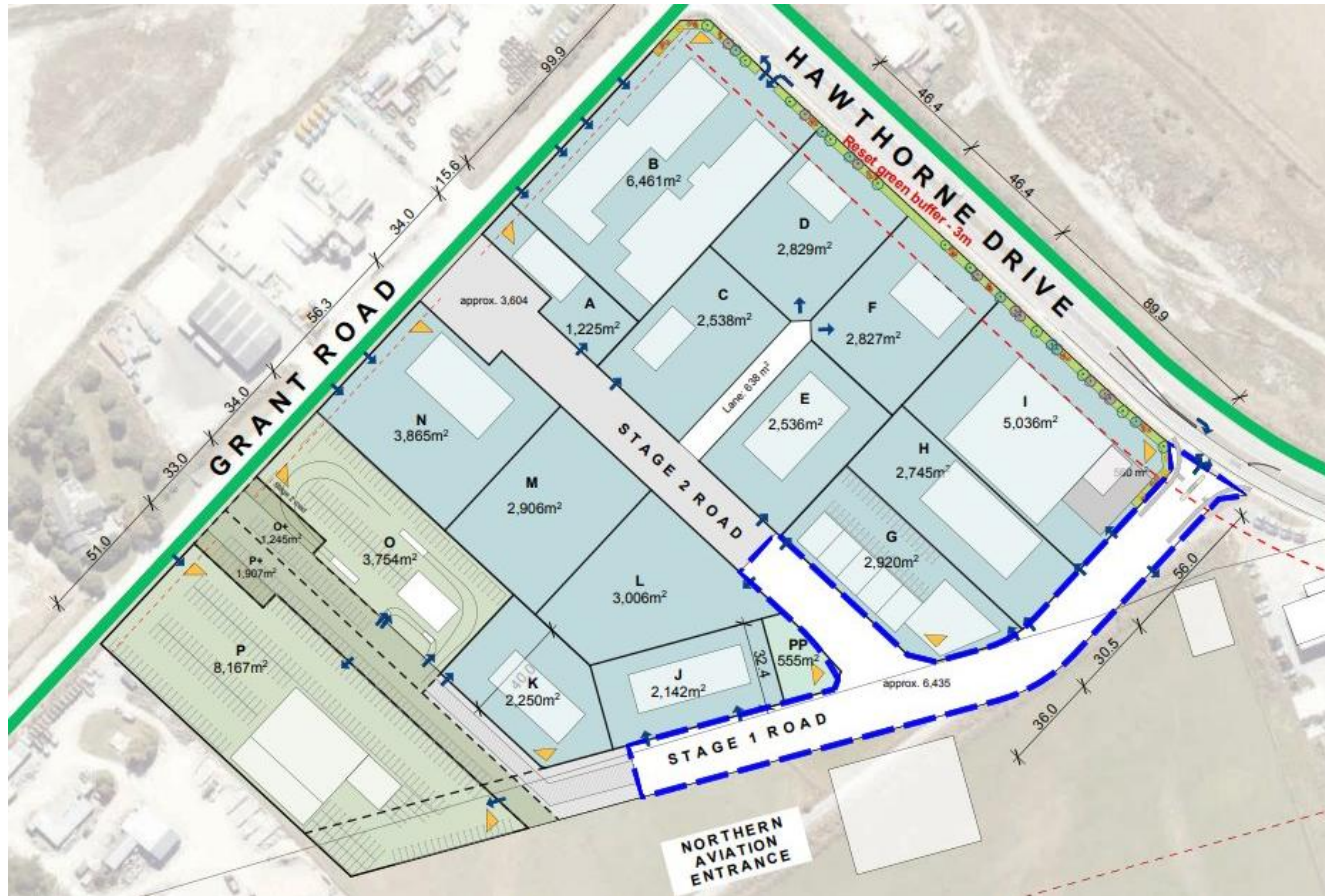

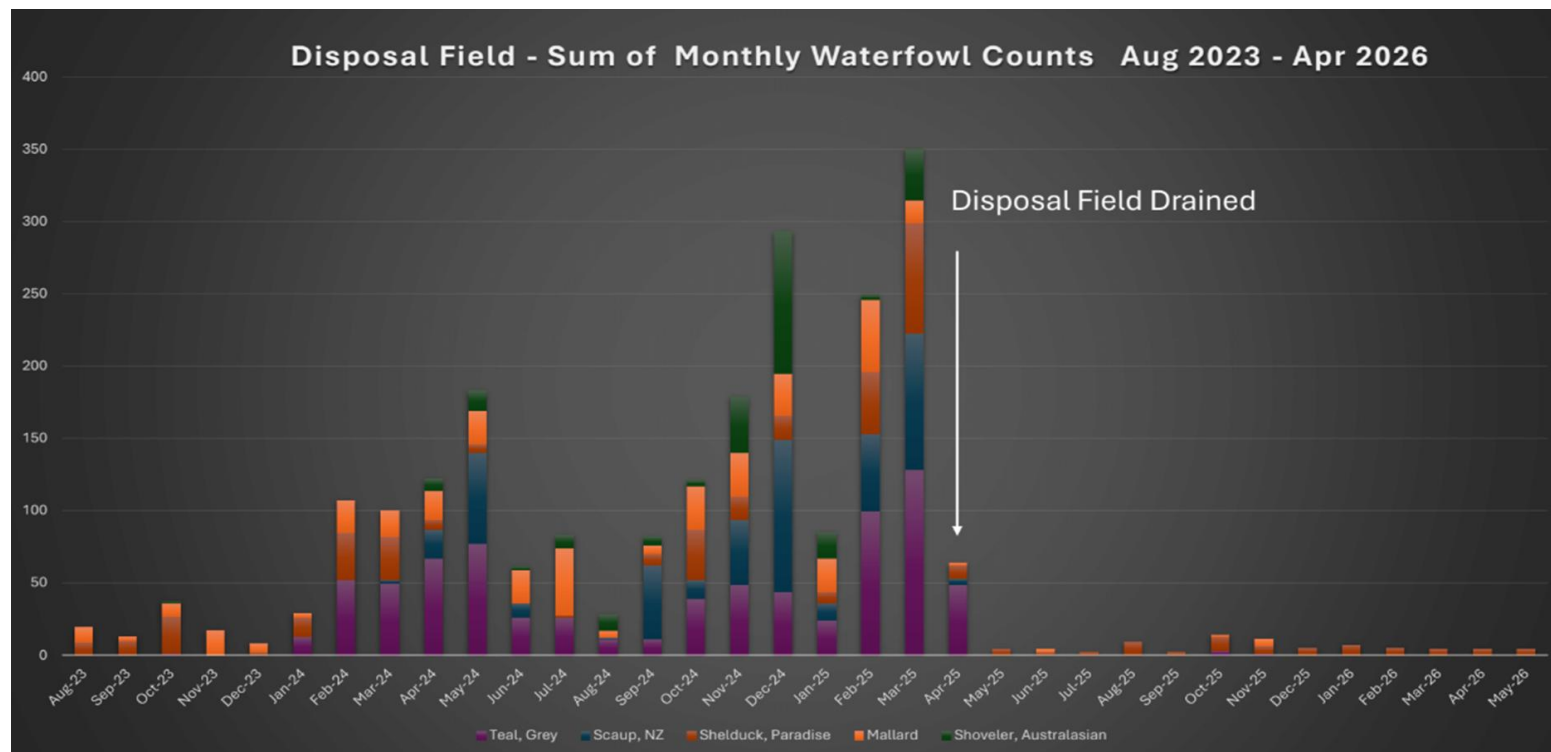
NORTHERN LAND INDICATIVE PARCELS



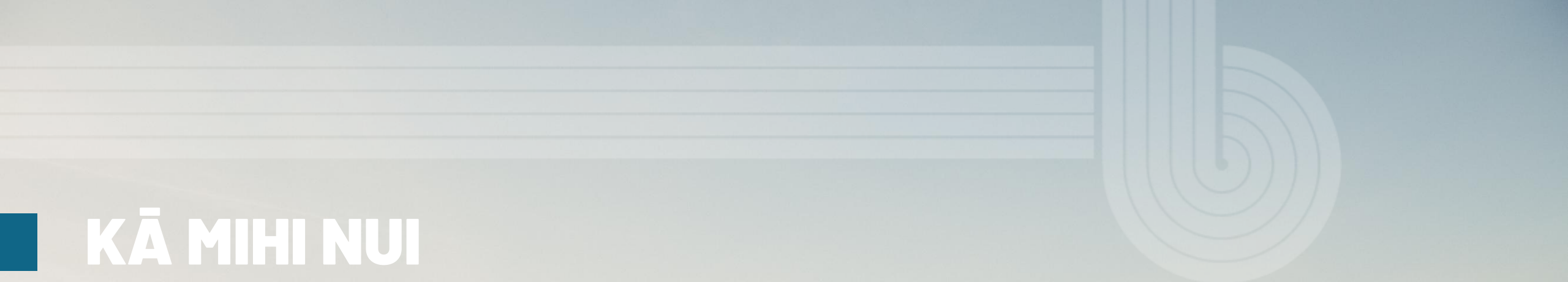
