Rabbit control operation planned for Wānaka Recreation Centre grounds

Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC) has employed the services of a professional contractor to carry out rabbit control on Wānaka Recreation Centre grounds. This will take place from 10.00pm on Tuesday 20 May for one hour, depending on the weather.

This control will be ongoing and will happen weekly on Tuesday evenings from 10.00pm, weather dependent.

Experienced professional contractors will carry out the night shooting operation within a cordoned off area.

- Please respect the cordon and DO NOT ENTER when signage and personnel are present.
- Public walking tracks will be closed. If you are asked to leave the area for safety reasons, please do so.
- Police have been notified of this rabbit control operation.
- Please be aware that noise from firearms, which are supressed, may be heard outside of the operational area.

Residents and businesses in the neighbourhood will be notified via a letter drop with details of the rabbit control operation.
