

Proposed Variation to the Proposed District Plan (PDP)

HĀWEA MAPPING



Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC) is proposing a variation to the Proposed District Plan (PDP), to make the following changes to planning maps.

1. Nine lots proposed to be rezoned from residential to reserve zone

- » These lots are currently zoned Lower Density Suburban Residential Zone (LDSRZ).
- » They have since been transferred to Council to be used as public reserves.
- » The proposed change will amend the maps so the land is zoned for recreation (Informal Recreation Subzone), aligning with its current public use.

2. Two Longview lots proposed to be rezoned from reserve to residential

- » Parts of two lots at Longview are currently zoned Informal Recreation Subzone.
- » This was a mapping error from a past Environment Court decision.
- » The change will correct the error by zoning these lots LDSRZ.

HOW TO HAVE YOUR SAY ON WHAT'S BEING PROPOSED

This variation is being limited notified to those directly affected by the proposal.

If you've been sent this fact sheet directly by QLDC, you have been determined to be **directly affected** by this variation and are able to have a say on what's being proposed. You can do this by making a submission; a formal process through which you can express your views, suggestions, or concerns and allows you to influence the decision(s) being made.
