## **Road Sealing Policy**

## Adopted – Utilities Committee 3 April 2002

Road sealing in all developments be undertaken in accordance with the following policy:

- 1. Roads shall be surfaced with either Option A, Option B or Option C type treatments where sealing is required.
- 2. All areas subject to high traffic stress shall only be sealed with Option C type treatment.
- 3. The maintenance period For Option A & C treatment shall be one year from the date of first coat seal.
- 4. The maintenance period For Option B treatment shall be one year from the date of second coat seal.
- 5. The developer shall be responsible for the rectification of all faults and defects that occur in the seal coat within the maintenance period to the satisfaction of Council's Engineer.
- 6. The developer shall be responsible for the completion of and total cost of all sealing except that for Option B the developer shall pay to Council, prior to the issue of a compliance certificate, the fixed sum set at the time of Consent for the second coat seal and Council shall undertake such second coat sealing.
- 7. Option A and B treatment shall not be undertaken in the period between 15 May and 15 September each year.
- 8. There shall be a period of one month between seal coats for an Option B treatment.
- 9. The minimum chip size in any chip seal coat shall be Grade 5
- 10. Where an access road serves less than three dwelling units the road shall be sealed with an Option C surfacing.

and

That acceptable sealing treatments shall be:

<u>Option A</u> Two application first coat plus second coat at least one construction season later.

<u>Option B</u> Single application first coat plus a second coat in the same construction season.

Option C Asphaltic concrete surfacing.

and

That Imtech Ltd will prepare technical specifications in accordance with the Subdivision Standards – Road Sealing policy statements for adoption by Council as amendments to NZS4404.
