Consultation on QLDC's Proposed Class 4 Gambling and TAB Venue Policy 2023

Queenstown Lakes District Council is seeking feedback on a proposed Class 4 Gambling and TAB Venue Policy 2023.

The Gambling Act 2003 and Racing Industry Act 2020 require councils across Aotearoa New Zealand to adopt a gaming venue policy, and to review the policy every three years. Consultation is required when there are proposed changes or amendments to the policy.

All proposed amendments in QLDC's proposed Class 4 Gambling and TAB Venue Policy 2023 are outlined in the Statement of Proposal.
